Presentation of Ferslev School

Ferslev School is situated south of Aalborg, the fourth largest city in Denmark with a population of 120.000 inhabitants.

The school is one of the fifty schools in the Aalborg municipal district. Ferslev School has 350 pupils in the age of 6 – 16 years in ten grades – 0th form to 9th form. The school is situated in rural surroundings with good opportunities to involve the nature when teaching.

Besides the professional training we give priority to children`s social and creative development. At school, there are many pieces of art done by students in collaboration with artist.

The staff consists of 50 persons: teachers, educators, leaders and technical and administrative staff.

The children are at school between 8.00 – 14.30. After school the children up to 12 years can go to after-school activities until 17 o´clock. Children from 12 – 16 years can join youth-classes in the evenings from Monday to Friday.

In the Aalborg municipal district we are three schools which work with a project that will broaden the students` horizons so they will appreciate the similarities and differences between people and learn to value diversities.

Global thinking as a standard of education

The purpose of the project is that the pupils learn to see themselves as citizens in two communities “the national community “ and “the global community”. Likewise they should learn to think globally and act locally. They have to learn seeing the consequences of their actions in a global context.

We should teach the pupils to acquire qualities, skills and knowledge so they can act in the “global society of knowledge”.

Parent–school cooperation

Danish schools is a tradition to hold school–home interviews – often twice during a school year. There are also held parent meeting for all class parents together. In addition to issues pertaining to the purely academic, is also discussed how students have socially with each other.
